

July 20th, 2011

Made it to the first Island locality, SE of
Bocas Pt on Sucrez.

Weather - light showers and a small breeze.
I've seen two piles of bear scat already
and I expect to have some bear encounters
at some point on this trip. Not too worried
about it though. My crew and I, (Sadie
Xrista, Stephen Greinier, Brad Truett) are in high
spirits and are excited about tomorrow's catch.
I sent Stephen up the river to set while Sadie
and myself trapped north and south coastal.
There is a lot of pero habitat and many trees
that flying squirrels should inhabit. Not much
microtis habitat on the coast here so I think
it is going to be a pero/shrew morning.

July 21st 2011

As predicted, only shrews and peros were
caught today. I've noticed some bear
scat around camp so we should be very
careful while checking traps around here.
The clouds have begun coming in pretty
heavy so we will likely get some rain
today. This area has blue berries as well
as salmon berries throughout so I really
hope to get flying squirrel in the morning.

July 22nd

Still no flying squirrel and the boat is scheduled to pick us up at noon today so I have to pull all traps and clear up camp. This morning's catch yielded quite a few gerbils as well as a couple of shrews from the pitfalls. This is the second time on this Island that flying squirrels have eluded me.

Just got a call from dispatch telling us that they are going to pick us up at 3:00pm instead so we have plenty of time to pack up shop.

We just got done moving everything down to the beach for pickup, which was around 200 yards and up slippery slopes to get a call at 2:50pm telling us that the boat broke down and they are going to have to pick us up tomorrow instead. I guess I get one more try at those squirrels! Setting the squirrel traps was good fun. Had to climb some trees and a few cliffs to get them set but I think it will be worth it. Everyone is a little bummed out that we had to put camp back up though.
