Integumentary: Subcutaneous bruising on the ventrum, caudal to the xiphoid process.

Musculoskeletal: Cartilage changes to the medial aspect of the left stifle (possibly secondary to a stifle injury in 2014). Severely emaciated.

Serosal Cavities: Multifocal masses on the omentum and diaphragm ranging in size from 0.1-1.5 cm. in diameter. Moderate amount of frank blood present.

Respiratory: Diffuse congestion and hemorrhage within the down lung.

Cardiovascular: Multiple fibrinous adhesions between the pericardium and heart were observed. Mitral valve appeared moderately thickened.

Oral Cavity: Moderate dental tartar, mild to moderate periodontal disease, multiple broken / worn teeth (tips only, no pulp exposure)



Hepatic mass with probable seeding of the serosal cavity (ie: carcinomatosis likely). Mass had ruptured leading to blood in the abdomen and likely was the underlying cause for the sudden decline. Severe emaciation likely indicates chronicity and cachexia.




