Utah, Iron County 37.691039 - 113.066219

NK 261202 - ear tags A14187 & A14186 was caught at the Cedar City Cemetery, ~UTM 317823 4173545 on 7/9/2010. Our records show this animal was translocated and released at ~UTM 398236 4178962, but I'm not sure if this is where the animal was found or not.

Utah, Iron County 37.689789 - 113.056783 200m error

NK 261216 - ear tags A14133 & A14132 was caught at the Cedar City Golf Course, ~UTM 318652 4173388 (very approximate!) on 7/8/2010. Again, our records show this animal was translocated and released, at ~UTM 380175 4191429, so I'm not sure if this is where the animal was found.

Utah, Iron County 37.871788 - 112.900449

NK 261207 - ear tags A21048 & A21049 was caught at the Parowan Valley Wildlife Management Area, ~UTM 332848 4193292 on 6/26/13. This dog was not translocated and probably picked up somewhat near its capture location.

As far as the others, I have no idea where they came from. We have literally dozens of locations where we trap dogs, so it would be a total guess.

- NK 261219 - no ear tags
- NK 261244 - no ear tags
