Rosa acicularis vs. Rosa nootka

Rosacea (rose family)

- Herbs with woody base or shrubs.
- Leaves alternate. Simple or compound, stipulate.
- 5-merous, with numerous stamens.
- Stamens, multiple.



Rosa acicularis Prickly Rose



- Slightly pubescent leaves
- Nonglandular



Simply serrate leaflets



Prickles

- Stem covered in prickles
- Small, sharp outgrowth of the epidermis



Rosa nootka Nootka Rose



- Pubescent
- Glandular Edges



Doubly Serrate Edges



Thorns

- Opposite
- Stiff, Woody, modified stem
- Easier to break off
